


## HOLT McDUGAL “How-To” Access Guide

IMPORTANT: Have a copy of the student’s e-learning schedule ready. This e-learning schedule will show you the URL, the username and password for websites being used in middle and high school.



This website holds the English textbooks used by many of our high school students. They are using the series titled “Collections”.


Step 1: Login
