





Accessing Microphone Permissions within Chrome:


- Select 3 dots in Chrome, located in right hand corner.

Search

Default - Internal Mic

Sites usually use your microphone for communication features like video chatting

Default behavior

Sites automatically follow this setting when you visit them

- Sites can ask to use your microphone
- Don't allow sites to use your microphone
Features that need a microphone won't work

Customized behaviors
